The International Junior Brangus Breeders Association would like to thank you for taking the first step toward attending our Legacy Leadership Conference on April 6-9, 2017 in Haines City, Florida. The IJBBA Board is working to make this event fun, educational and memorable for everyone. This event will focus on increasing your knowledge of the Brangus breed and the beef industry as well as building your leadership skills. There will be industry tours, ranch tours, motivational speakers and lots of other fun-filled events.

New this year, we have extended the schedule to include an additional full day of activities! A tentative schedule of events is enclosed (Page 6) for your reference. Please note this schedule is subject to change as industry and ranch tours are organized and finalized.

Our host location for the conference will be the Florida FFA Leadership Training Center, located at 5000 Firetower Road, Haines City, Florida 33844. There will be 4 juniors to a room. Please list preferred roommate requests on your form and we will do our best to accommodate such requests.

This conference is open to all current IJBBA members and any other youth ages 9 – 22. The registration fee is \$100 for current IJBBA members or \$125 for non-current IJBBA members. The Registration Form, Rules and Expectations Agreement, Liability Waiver and Medical Release forms (pages 3-5 of this packet) must be returned along with your registration fee by February 15, 2017. Late registrations will be accepted through February 28, 2017 at double the cost (provided space is available). The registration fee includes everything at the conference including meals, hotel, transportation and tour fees. No refunds for registration will be given after February 15, 2017.

Also, new this year, because of the number of tours we are going on and required buses, IJBBA will have a maximum number of participants that will be allowed to attend. We highly recommend that you get your registration forms turned in early in order to ensure a spot in the conference. Any registrations received after the maximum has been reached will be notified and held on a waiting list. Maximums are determined by bus seating so it is possible that you may be on waiting list briefly until we fill an additional bus. If you register and something comes up that is going to prevent you from attending, we request that you notify me as soon as possible so that I can move someone up from the waiting list.

Participants are responsible for transportation to and from the conference. IJBBA is working to arrange a charter bus for group transportation. The route is tentatively planned to leave Kansas/Oklahoma, head south into Texas, and then east, but final route will not be determined until registrations are received; however, the fee to ride the IJBBA charter bus across country will be \$125. We realize that this transportation will be the only way attendance is possible for some, so if your registration is dependent upon the bus, please check the box on the registration form. If we fail to have enough people interested in the group transportation by February 15, your registration will be shredded and your registration check returned to you. The sooner we know how many attendees we will have from a region, the better we can work on making this happen. If you have any questions, please contact me.

Everyone driving to the conference should plan to arrive at the hotel no later than 5:00 pm on Thursday, April 6 and depart no earlier than 10:00am on Sunday, April 9.

Anyone who will be flying to the conference should make their flight arrangements to arrive at Orlando International Airport in Orlando, Florida or Tampa International Airport in Tampa, Florida by 3:00 pm on Thursday, April 6 and depart at or after 11:30 am on Sunday, April 9. IJBBA will work with those flying to help arrange transportation to and from these respective airports. Please send your flight schedule along with your registration form so that we can coordinate your pick up from the airport. The closer you can arrive and depart to the times mentioned the better.

Parents and chaperones are also invited to attend. The registration fee for parents and/or chaperones is \$75 plus the cost of their hotel room (\$100/night). All other costs during the conference will be covered by the registration fee. Parents and chaperones need to complete their own registration form and include payment (both registration fee and hotel room cost).

Every registered participant will receive a conference t-shirt. Sizes need to be listed on the registration form and t-shirts will be distributed at registration. Everyone will be required to wear their conference t-shirt on Saturday, April 8. Appropriate dress for all other activities is outlined on the rules and expectations agreement. Please remember you are representing the IJBBA and appropriate dress is required.

Registration confirmation letters and an updated schedule will be mailed to each attendee on or before March 10, 2017.

### Basic Rules of Participation and Behavior for Legacy Leadership Conference
